

## **FORTRAN HOMEWORK GRADING POLICY**

### **ENCE 202, Spring 2000**

Each homework will be graded out of a possible 3 points using (as a default) the grading scheme listed below.

**1 point:** E-mail message with your FORTRAN program attachment is received properly. This program must be named to match your surname (last name) with a ".for" extension. So, for example, Dr. Assakkaf would e-mail a homework with attached file "assakkaf.for" for each homework assignment.

**1 point:** Your program compiles and links with no errors. I will not be debugging your code for you, so any error (regardless of severity) will make you lose this point.

**1 point:** Your program runs and produces the correct output. Again, I expect your output to be completely correct, and I shall deduct this entire point if your output has any errors (regardless of error number or type).

Using this scheme, a program that is e-mailed correctly, compiles, links, and runs correctly will receive 100% credit (3 points). A program that is e-mailed correctly, compiles, links, but does not run correctly will receive 66% (2 points). A program that is e-mailed correctly but does not compile and link will receive 33% (1 point). Finally, a program that is not e-mailed correctly will receive 0% (0 points).

#### **Late policy:**

You must e-mail your homework solution by 11 pm on the due date to receive full credit. You will receive a 1 point.(33%) deduction for each 24-hour day you are late, up to 2 days late after which time you will receive no credit.
